Flower Power

Clusters Of Color

Achillea: A low mound of fragrant, ferny foliage; clusters of flowers atop upright stems.

- Height: 16–20 inches
- Zone: 5 to 9

Daisy-Like Rays

Coreopsis: Bicolor blooms have a contrasting dark ring around the eye.

- Height: 12–14 inches
- Zone: 5 to 9

Echinacea: Coneflowers in a mix of pretty colors; durable, with a bushy, upright habit.

- Height: 26–32 inches
- Zone: 4 to 9

Leucanthemum: Lots of long-lasting white daisy flowers on a bushy mound of foliage.

- Height: 14–18 inches
- Zone: 4 to 8

Rudbeckia: Classic golden black-eyed Susans with lots of single flowers on sturdy stems.

- Height: 24–28 inches
- Zone: 3 to 9

Year After Year

Do the work once with Perennials and you'll reap the rewards year after year. These plants grow more valuable with time because they get bigger and more established. There are many varieties to choose from in a range of sizes, colors, and textures. Invest some time initially planning your garden design, then relax and enjoy the landscape in the seasons to come. Aquilegia: Unusual large, spurred bicolor blooms in vibrant colors.
Height: 18–20 inches | Zone: 3 to 8

Hibiscus (Perennial): Large, tropical looking dinner-plate blooms.
Height: 48 inches | Zone: 5 to 9



Dianthus, Coreopsis & Echinacea

Simply Stunning

Dianthus: Lacy flowers with fringed petals; dense mound of grass-like gray-green leaves.

- Height: 6-24 inches
- Zone: 3 to 8

Phlox: Upright variety with large heads of abundant flowers on well-branched stems.

- Height: 16-18 inches
- Zone: 4 to 9

Spike Some Vertical Garden Interest

Buddleia: Bright, billowy cone-like blooms that butterflies love.

Height: 36-48 inches | Zone: 5 to 9

Delphinium: Elegant, sturdy spikes densely covered in blooms.

Height: 24-36 inches | Zone: 3 to 7

Digitalis: Upright stalks of tubular flowers with spotted throats.

Height: 16-20 inches | Zone: 5 to 9

Lavender: Fragrant lavender brushes; mounded gray-green foliage.

Height: 10-14 inches | Zone: 5 to 8

Lobelia: Dense spikes covered with unique bird-shaped flowers.

Height: 20-24 inches | Zone: 6 to 10

Lupine: Vibrant, uniform rockets launch out of a clump of green.

Height: 20-24 inches | Zone: 4 to 6

Salvia: Long-blooming spikes of eye-popping, rich violet-purple.

Height: 18-24 inches | Zone: 4 to 9

Veronica: Lots of full, tapered flower spikes waving in the air.

Height: 12-18 inches | Zone: 4 to 8
