Lantana: Drought tolerant. Vibrant flower colors are often mixed in the same cluster. Aromatic foliage.

- Height: 15-20 inches
- Spread: 18-24 inches

Portulaca: Drought tolerant. AKA: Moss rose. An easy-care, low-growing groundcover with thick succulent foliage that retains water. Lovely large flowers on a full trailing habit.

- Height: 4-8 inches

Lantana: Bright Multicolor Orbs

Mounds of dark green foliage are topped by vibrant ball-shaped flower clusters all summer long! A standard go-to for bright, tropical color, Lantana thrives in extreme heat, humidity, and drought. It bounces right back after rainstorms and other stressful weather conditions and is extremely low-maintenance. Beautiful Lantana fills a space quickly with a nice, full canopy of color. It's striking when planted en masse in a large, sunny bed, and also looks great in oversized planters and urns.



Verbena Cadet Series

Highly Attractive

Verbena: Bees and butterflies love it! This is a garden variety with an upright habit that does not trail. It's tough, disease resistant, and great in patio pots!

- Height: 8-10 inches
- Spread: 12-14 inches

Vinca: Bees and butterflies are frequent visitors! Our Titan series has very large flowers and lots of blooms constantly all summer.

- Height: 14-16 inches
- Spread: 10-12 inches

Pentas: A magnet for butterflies and hummingbirds! Vibrant little star-shaped flowers cover the lush, full foliage nonstop. Durable plant with a neat, upright habit.

Dazzle With Double Zahara Zinnia

With vibrant shades and interesting forms Zinnia can transform a ho-hum garden bed into a lavish display. Zahara varieties are especially dependable for their tolerance to drought, heat, and disease as the temperatures climb during the height of the season. At 16-20 inches tall and wide, Zinnia works in the middle to the front of the border and is handy for filling in bare spots in a sunny garden. During the long, hot days of summer you'll appreciate an all-Zinnia design! Plant a solid block rather than a narrow row to show off the pretty flowers.

Special Liberty Sunflowers

Rise and shine! Bright yellow Liberty Sunflowers bring your garden to life with blooms that are more colorful and longer lasting than typical varieties. Plants keep growing outdoors long after traditional Sunflowers have bloomed and died, 9-10 weeks as opposed to the usual 3-4 weeks, blooming the entire time. Just water often to keep the soil moist but not soggy—it's well worth the effort. Liberty Sunflowers provide mess-free cut flowers with very little pollen and very few seeds, but bees, birds, and butterflies still flock to the radiant blooms and abundant nectar!
